

Seizure First Aid

How to help someone having a seizure

1

STAY with the person until they are awake and alert after the seizure.

- ✓ **Time** the seizure
- ✓ Remain **calm**
- ✓ Check for **medical ID**

- ✓ Ho'oana i ka lō'ihi o ka ma'i huki
- ✓ Ho'omau i ka noho malu 'ana
- ✓ 'Imi aku i ka lākou kāleka mālama olakino

Keep the person **SAFE.**

- ✓ Move or guide away from **harm**



E mālama PALEKANA i ka mea ma'i.

- ✓ Ho'one'e 'a i 'ole e 'alaka'i iā lākou mai ka 'eha mai

Turn the person onto their **SIDE** if they are not awake and aware.

- ✓ Keep **airway clear**
- ✓ Loosen **tight clothes** around neck
- ✓ Put **something small and soft** under the head



E ho'omoe i ka mea ma'i ma ko lākou 'AO'AO inā 'a'ole lākou i ala maika'i.

- ✓ Ho'ohāmama i ka paipu hanu
- ✓ Hō'alu i nā lole i pilik'i ma ka 'ā'T
- ✓ Ho'okomo i kekahi mea li'il'i a palupalu ma lalo o kō lākou po'o

- Seizure lasts longer than 5 minutes
- Person does not return to their usual state
- Person is injured, pregnant, or sick
- Repeated seizures
- First time seizure
- Difficulty breathing
- Seizure occurs in water

- Inā nā 'oi aku ka ma'i huki maō 5 minuke a 'oi
- Ala kūpono 'ole ka mea mai a kū i kō lākou 'ano ma'amau
- Ua 'eha ka mea ma'i, hāpai paha, a i 'ole ma'i paha
- Mau nō ka loa'a pinepine ka ma'i huki
- Kō lākou manawa mua loa i loa'a ai i ka ma'i huki mua loa
- Hana nui ka hanu 'ana
- Ua loa'a i ka ma'i huki i loko o ka wai/kai

- ✗ Do **NOT** restrain.
- ✗ Do **NOT** put any objects in their mouth.
- ✓ **Rescue medicines can be given** if prescribed by a health care professional

✗ MAI ho'opa'a, pūliki i ka mea ma'i.

✗ MAI ho'okomo i kekahi mea i loko o ka waha.

✓ Ua hiki ke ha'awi 'ia nā lā'au lapa'au kōkua inā ua kauoha 'ia e kekahi laekahi mālama olakino
