MEMBERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO:

- Serve a two-year term from November 1, 2019 – October 31, 2020.
- Attend one in-person national meeting per year (expenses paid).
- Participate in quarterly virtual meetings which will last approximately one hour each.
- Actively engage in the CYE AC by expressing personal viewpoints through:
 - Reviewing and commenting on proposed activities of the National Coordinating Center for Epilepsy
 - Providing feedback on items such as policies, procedures, and educational materials on an ongoing basis, as needed.
 - Actively engage in the work of the CYE AC by expressing personal viewpoints and issues.
