How to help someone having a seizure

- STAY with the person until they are awake and alert after the seizure — be sure to time the seizure
 - Remain calm
 - Check for medical ID
- Keep the person SAFE Move or guide away from harm

Turn the person onto their **SIDE** if they are not awake and aware — be sure to keep airway clear

- · Loosen tight clothes around neck • Put something small and soft under the head

Seizure first aid continued

CALL • Seizure lasts longer than 5 minutes

911 IF • First time seizure Difficulty breathing

 Person does not return to their usual state Repeated seizures

DO NOT • Put any objects in their mouth Restrain

 Seizure occurs in water Person is injured, preanant, or sick

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
